PHYSICAL ABILITIES TEST (PAT)

- 475 yard obstacle course (3:15 min.)
- Run under 2-3 foot bars
- Climb 2- 6 foot ladders
- Staircase with 67 steps (run up & down)
- Slalom through 7 stationary cones
- Climb 3 foot, 4 foot, and 6 foot wall
- Dummy drag (150 lbs.) over 27 ft.

OUT OF TOWN APPLICANT PROCESS

Applicants living more than 100 miles from San Diego qualify for condensed application timeframe.

Application Process Requires 3 Trips to San Diego

First Trip: Written Test, PAT, PIQ

Second Trip: Detective Interview, Polygraph

Third Trip: Lt. Interview, Psych & Medical Exam
